Biography:

James F. Hartmann was appointed by Governor Bill Owens to the Nineteenth Judicial District Court Bench on August 26, 2002, and Judge Hartmann took the bench on March 1, 2003. Prior to his judicial appointment, Judge Hartmann was a Deputy District Attorney for the Weld County District Attorney's Office for twelve years, with the last three years serving as Chief Deputy District Attorney. Judge Hartmann received his law degree from the University of Idaho and his undergraduate degree from the University of Northern Colorado. Judge Hartmann began serving as the Water Judge for Water Division One and as Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial District in 2009.
